SOLARI MEMBER GUIDELINES:

- 1. No cell phones allowed in the meetings.
- 2. No electronic recordings of the meetings.
- 3. Chatham House Rules will be followed.
 - a) Anyone who comes to a meeting is free to use information from the discussion, but is not allowed to reveal who made any comment. It is designed to increase openness of discussion. The rule is a system for holding debates and discussion panels on controversial topics.

- 4. Allow others to have a different opinion then yours.
- 5. No interruption of speakers. Stay on topic.
- 6. Be punctual when attending meetings.
- 7. For meetings held at the church, consider making a donation. The church allows us to use it's facility for free.
- 8. Asking a person to do a presentation is not an endorsement of that person or their business if they have one.
- 9. For presenters at our meetings:
 - a) We ask people to do presentations at our meetings, because they have information that help us with our educational mission.
 - b) In return, if the presenter has a business, it is an opportunity for them to promote their business during the presentation.
 - c) We do not get involved in the marketing of the business after the presentation.
- 10. Contact List:
 - a) Members can opt to be included in the contact list (or not).
 - b) It will only be available as a hard copy printout. It will not be available electronically.
 - c) Only members can receive a copy.
 - d) The contact list is for the sharing of ideas. It is not to be used for promoting a business.
